to the Resolution of the Board of the Faculty of Environmental Engineering no 50 /2007 of 18 December 2007

**REGULATIONS**

on studies according to **Individualised Study Programme (ISP)**  
at the Faculty of Environmental Engineering

1. The ISP can be requested by a student who has successfully completed at least the second year of studies and their average of grades is no lower than 4.0.
2. The student applying for the ISP should:
  - request an academic teacher authorised to supervise a diploma thesis to act as their academic tutor,
  - with the tutor, design the programme of further studies and submit it to the Dean for approval.
3. The ISP programme shall include common specialisation subjects, and at least 60% of subjects being part of a given specialisation. The total number of hours and the number of ECTS points shall be no less than the number specified for a given specialisation.
4. The ISP shall be approved by the Dean and its completion shall be monitored by the Dean's Office in accordance with the same procedures as used to monitor the progress of other students.
5. Changes to the ISP may be proposed to the Dean on the basis of a joint request of the student and the tutor. The decision on approval of the changes is made by the Dean. The changes may be introduced no later than during the first month of the semester.
6. Where difficulties arise in the implementation of an ISP, the Dean, in consultation with the tutor, shall take a decision allowing further implementation of the programme, adjusting it or withdrawing consent for the ISP. In case the consent for the ISP is withdrawn, the student shall complete the programme of a given specialisation.
7. The ISP shall not result in increasing the length of studies.
8. Studying chosen subjects at other WUT faculties or other universities shall not encumber the Faculty of Environmental Engineering financially.

The regulations shall apply from the day of their adoption by the Faculty Board.
